

NHAI expects to complete ECR expansion project in Mayiladuthurai
and Karaikal by July 2024 | 1



By July 2024, the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) expects to have completed the East Coast Road expansion projects in the districts of Mayiladuthurai and Karaikal.

National Highway-32, which uses East Coast Road to connect Chennai and Thoothukudi, is being widened by NHAI.

A 55-kilometer route between Kadavacherry and Vanjore is being expanded, at a cost of about Rs 2,661.75 crore. The project covers the districts of Cuddalore and Nagapattinam. The agency is currently speeding up the project.

The project becomes more significant as a result of its essential contribution to enhancing communication between coastal regions and the ports of Chennai, Thoothukudi, and Karaikal.
