



As part of the Patna ring road project in the state of Bihar, the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has issued an invitation for bids for the building of a six-lane bridge across the Ganga.

Construction of a six-lane bridge and its approaches over the Ganga is included in the scope of work for the Patna Ring Road (NH-131G), which runs from kilometre 8.480 near Sherpur to km 23.000 near Dighwara.

The project is expected to cost Rs 4,994.79 crore and would take 42 months to complete.
