



Indian Railways has responded positively to a request of the plant-based food industries for a cold storage facility at Bengaluru railway station, according to the Plant Based Foods Industry Association (PBFIA).

According to a PBFIA statement, the association's team, led by Executive Director Sanjay Sethi, approached Shyam Singh, Divisional Railway Manager of South Western Railway, and Kusuma Hariprasad, Additional Divisional Manager, to assist in making Bengaluru the epicentre for plant-based foods.
