

A 200 MW wind power project worth Rs 1,400 crore was won by the state-owned SJVN Ltd arm SJVN Green Energy in a tariff-based competitive bidding process run by Solar Energy Corporation of India.

According to a BSE filing, SJVN Green Energy would create this wind power facility anywhere in India under an EPC (engineering procurement construction) contract.

The tentative cost of construction/development of this project is Rs 1,400 crore, it said. SJVN Green Energy, a wholly-owned subsidiary of SJVN Ltd, participated in the tariff-based competitive bidding process for the selection of wind power developers for setting up of 1,200 MW ISTS (inter-state transmission system) connected wind power projects in India (Phase-XIV) conducted by Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI).

SJVN Green Energy bagged the full quoted capacity of a 200 MW wind power project at the rate of Rs 3.24/Unit on a build own and operate (BOO) basis through e-RA (reverse auction) conducted on June 12, 2023.
