

Vedanta signs pacts with 30 Japanese firms to develop Indian semiconductor manufacturing ecosystem | 1



In order to create an Indian semiconductor and glass display manufacturing ecosystem, Vedanta Group announced on Tuesday that it had agreements in place with 30 Japanese technology businesses.

The agreements were signed last week in Tokyo, Japan at the Vedanta-Avanstrate Business Partners Summit 2022. More than 200 participants from more than 100 international companies attended the summit.
